CCNA Courses

CCNA Introduction to Networks: By the end of the course, students will be able to build simple LANs, perform basic configurations for routers and switches and implement IP addressing schemes.

- Offered Fully Online:

 - Sept 8 – Oct 14, 2017, meeting on Saturday mornings for ~2 hours each

CCNA Routing and Switching Essentials: This course describes the architecture, components, and operations of routers and switches in a small network.

 - Oct 28 – Dec 2, 2017, meeting on Saturday mornings for ~2 hours each

CCNA Scaling Networks: By the end of this course, students will be able to configure and troubleshoot routers and switches and resolve common issues with OSPF, EIGRP, STP, and VTP in both IPv4 and IPv6 networks.

CCNA Connecting Networks: The course enables students to understand the selection criteria of network devices and WAN technologies to meet network requirements.

CCNA Instructor Fast Track: Instructor Fast Track (IFT) is an alternate training option meant for select instructors who demonstrate requisite subject knowledge and technical skills. A successful candidate proves proficiency in course content through the successful completion of a skills based assessment. There is no instruction with this course, only a Skills Based Assessment [SBA]. **A current CCNA R&S certification is required.** Cost is \$500. IT Essentials v6: PC Hardware and Software v6.0 covers the fundamentals of computer hardware and software as well as advanced concepts. ITE 6.0 curriculum prepares students for the CompTIA A+ certification exams 220-901 and 220-902.

CCNA Security: CCNA Security is a hands-on, career-oriented e-learning solution with an emphasis on practical experience to help students develop specialized security skills to advance their careers.

CCNP

CCNP Routing: This course teaches students how to implement, monitor and maintain routing services in an enterprise network. Cost is \$900.

CCNP Switching: This course teaches students how to implement, monitor and maintain switching in converged enterprise campus networks. Cost is \$900

CCNP TShoot: This course teaches students to (1) plan and perform regular maintenance on complex enterprise routed and switched networks and (2) use technology-based practices and a systematic ITIL compliant approach to perform network troubleshooting. The cost is \$900

- **CCNP & CCNA Security Costs**
 - Online, new instructors \$900
- **Refreshers for any class except Fast Track**
 - \$100 [must meet the below requirements for this cost]

- **Instructor Fast Track** [for well qualified candidates, there is no instructor training component involved and a valid, current industry certification is required]
 - IT-E \$320, held in conjunction with the regular class
 - CCNA \$500, dates are listed above
 - CCNP \$500, contact Karen Stanton to schedule the IFT
 - CCNA Sec \$500, held in conjunction with the regular class
